Emergency Shelter / Self-Refer / No Fees

Men's Drop-In Shelter | Porchlight, Inc. | 116 W Washington Ave, Madison, WI 53703

Description: Located in the lower levels of Grace Episcopal Church on the Capitol Square. Entrance through the central courtyard. Night shelter only. 60-night limit for the shelter year from Nov 1 – Oct 31. Weather exceptions for all nights below 20° w/wind chill or during other inclement weather; extensions granted on a case-by-case basis as a bridge to housing or employment.

Hours for Apr – Oct: 7:30PM – 7:00AM; Nov – Mar: 5:00PM – 7:00AM

Services Include: Dinner, breakfast, personal grooming supplies, laundry, & counseling services

Domestic Abuse Intervention Services (DAIS)

Description: Helps individuals who are experiencing intimate partner violence. To access shelter, call the DAIS Help Line
